The Salem Township Board of Trustees met on March 9, 2021 in regular session at the Salem Township Fire Station Conference Room for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township. Trustee Susan Ramsey called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with Trustees Heath Kilburn and Ralph Blanton present. Mrs. Ramsey led all those present in the pledge to the flag.

Meeting Minutes:

The trustees read the minutes from the February 23, 2021 meeting. Mr. Kilburn made a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Blanton seconded the motion.

- Tire Recycle Event dates for Turtlecreek Township is April 10, 2021 and Wayne Township is April 24, 2021
- Gheils Carrol Rd – update - Contacted Greg Carmack of the Warren County Engineers office and he said the Speed limit on any township road is 55MPH unless posted otherwise. He asked the County to do a speed study on Gheils Carrol Rd for us
- Niche’s update –
 - City of Lebanon was put in in 1996. They have sold 26 of them mostly in the past two years. Their cost is \$1,400 each
 - Goshen put theirs in 2020. They have had no sales to date. Their cost is \$1,200 each and that includes etching
 - The one located in Bellbrook is new and has a total of 40 niches to sell

Mr. Blanton suggested that they all keep looking into this idea before they make any decisions. Everyone agreed.
